

CHAPEL OF SAINT-MELAINE Consecrated to a local man who became adviser to King Clovis.

THE RUINED CASTLE OF CHÂTEAU DE RIEUX (D) Once a strategic fortress of the Kingdom of Brittany.

LA BUTTE DES 5 MOULINS (E)

Discover historic windmills and watermills on the moorland around Saint-Jacut-les-Pins.
